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Borders College Performance Indicators 2022 - 2023

The Scottish Funding Council (SFC) publishes annual Performance Indicators (PIs) for all of Scotland's colleges. PIs reflect the success rates of students undertaking a course of study.

The SFC PIs cover four modes of study:

Full-time Further Education (FTFE): These are courses that usually begin in August and usually finish in June, and cover Scottish Credit Qualification Framework (SCQF) levels 1 – 6

Part-time Further Education (PTFE): These are courses lasting anything from one day to one year and cover SCQF levels 1 – 6

Full-time Higher Education (FTHE): These are courses that usually begin in August and end in June, and range from SCQF levels 7 – 12

Part-time Higher Education (PTHE): These are courses that start any time within an academic session and range from SCQF levels 7 – 12

The PIs themselves measure four factors:

Early Withdrawals (EW) This applies to students who started on

their course and left before a certain date, usually 1st week of November, or before completing 25% of their course*

Further Withdrawals (FW) This applies to students who started

their course but left after the early

withdrawal date*

Completed Partial Success (CPS) This applies to students who stayed

until the end of their course and completed part of their programme

Completed Successfully (CS) This applies to students who began

their course and successfully completed

their course

For Academic Year 2022/23, Borders College is pleased to report performance above the national average in three out of four modes of study.

Throughout every academic session, Borders College has measures in place to continually review how we are performing. We work closely with our Students' Association to gather feedback from our students on their course. We liaise regularly with our key stakeholders to ensure the curriculum is relevant, future-focused and meets the needs of both regional and national priorities. We continually review and assess the quality of our provision to ensure our staff are confident and skilled in delivering an education that continues to meet our strategic ambition of being 'Regionally Focused and Globally Engaged'.

*It must be noted that many students leave college for a number of reasons, such as employment or a change in their personal circumstances.

















Chart 8. FE Outcomes by ES subject group on courses lasting 160 hours or more




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Chart 10. Outcomes by level and gender on courses lasting 160 hours or more


